MEET THE INTERNATIONAL SPEAKER

Professor Peter Hellings is the Former Secretary General of the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology (EAACI, 2015–2019). He is the Clinic Head at the University Hospitals of Leuven, Belgium and a Professor at the Catholic University of Leuven (KU Leuven) and the Academic Medical Centre, University of Amsterdam. He leads a research consortia on global airway allergy and nasal mucosal pathology. His research has developed novel insights into the pathophysiology of allergy and chronic airway inflammation and he has published over 230 manuscripts in this field of medicine. He is an active member of the international expert committees on allergic airway diseases (ARIA, Allergic Rhinitis and its Impact on Asthma) and rhinosinusitis (EPOS, European Position Paper on Rhinosinusitis and Nasal Polyps).
