


# Highlights

#### **ASCIA WEBSITE**


The <u>ASCIA website</u> continues to provide new and updated world leading, accessible, consistent and evidence-based information about allergy and other immune diseases.

ASCIA lodged 15 submissions from 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022. ASCIA also advocates through collaborations with over 30 other groups.


# **ASCIA E-TRAINING COURSES**

## **LAUNCHES**

The <u>ASCIA Immunodeficiency Strategy for Australia and New Zealand</u> was launched on World Immunology Day, 29 April 2022, with a follow up event on World HAE Day, 16 May 2022. Media coverage was extensive for both events.
